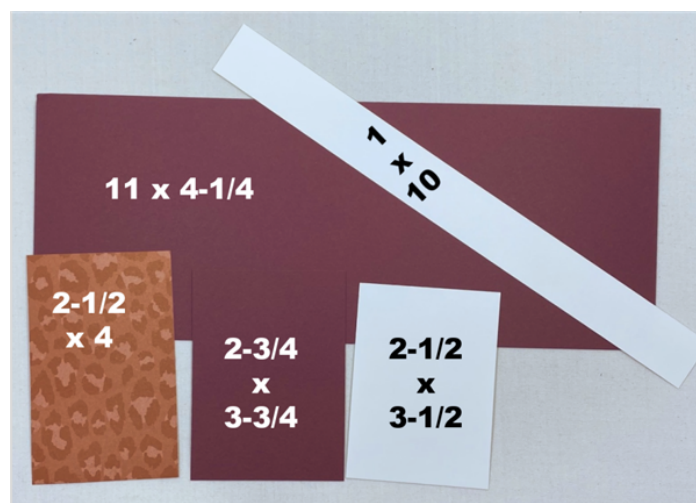

## Version #1



Score the large piece @  $2\text{-}3/4$  &  $5\text{-}1/2$ .

Score the narrow strip @  $2\text{-}3/4$  &  $5\text{-}1/2$ .

Stamp your sentiment on the shortest fold and attach that to the edge of the card.

Add adhesive under the left edge and close up the card and attach that.

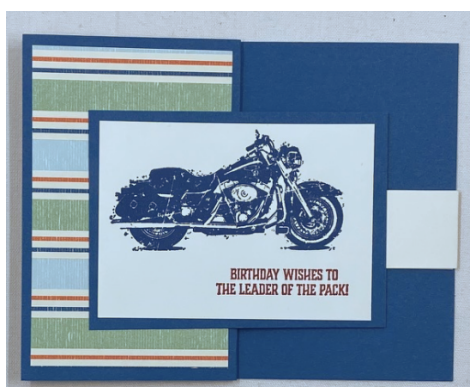
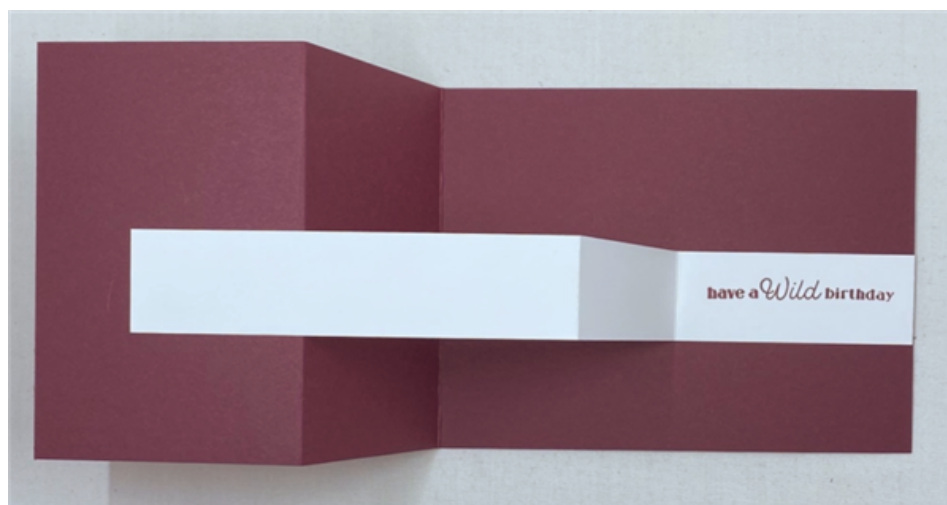

After scoring the long piece, turn it and cut in at 1" from 3" to 7-1/2".

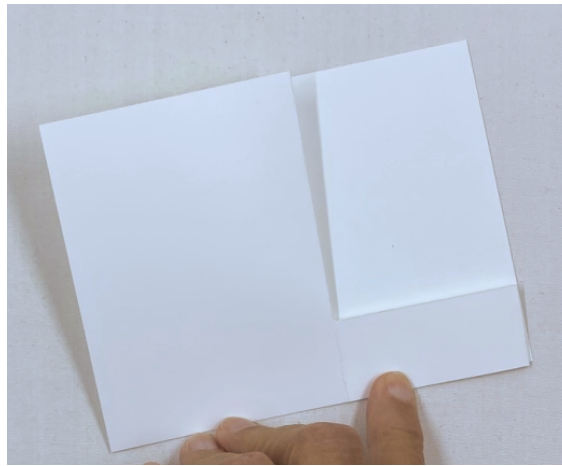
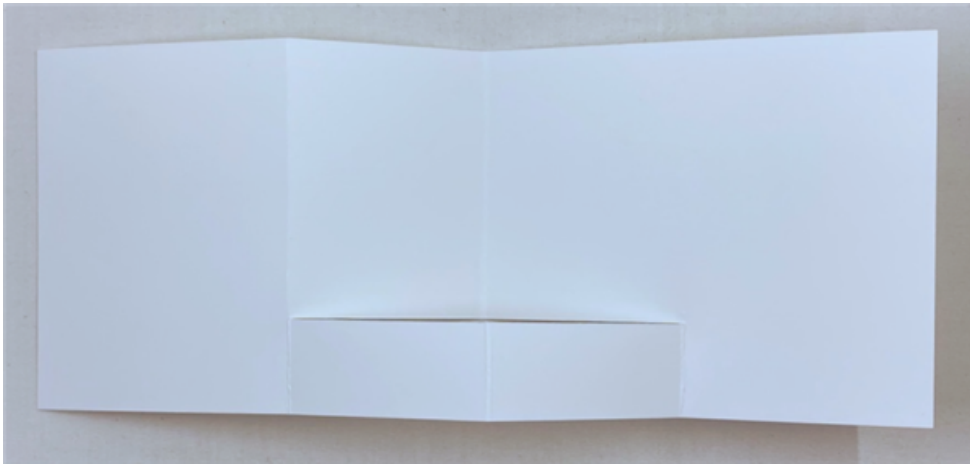


Score at 7-1/2" just the lower 1". Fold the card like this and attach to the base card.
