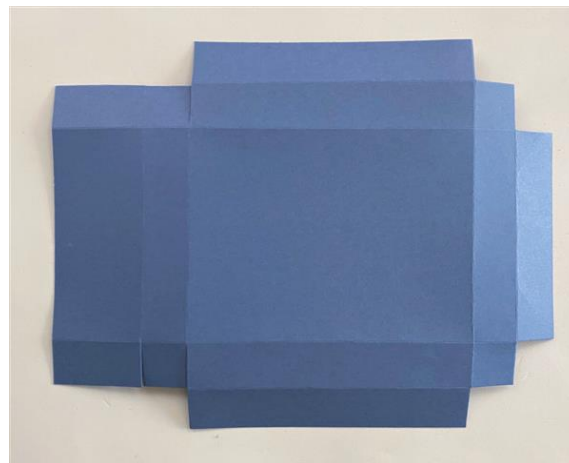

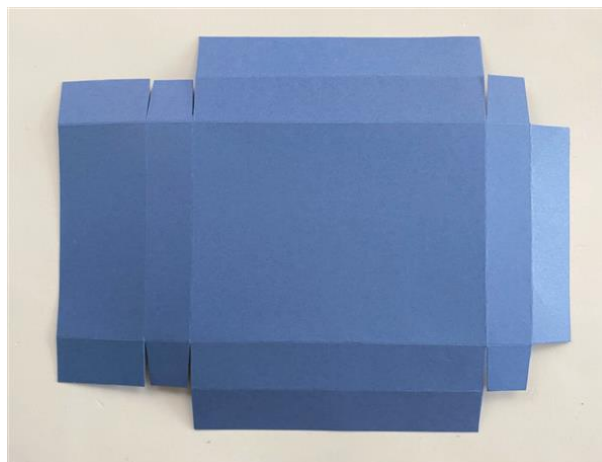
Score at 2" and 3" along one 8-1/2" side. Then rotate cardstock and score at 1" and 2" on the other three sides.



Cut off the corners like this.



Cut v shapes as shown.

Add adhesive.



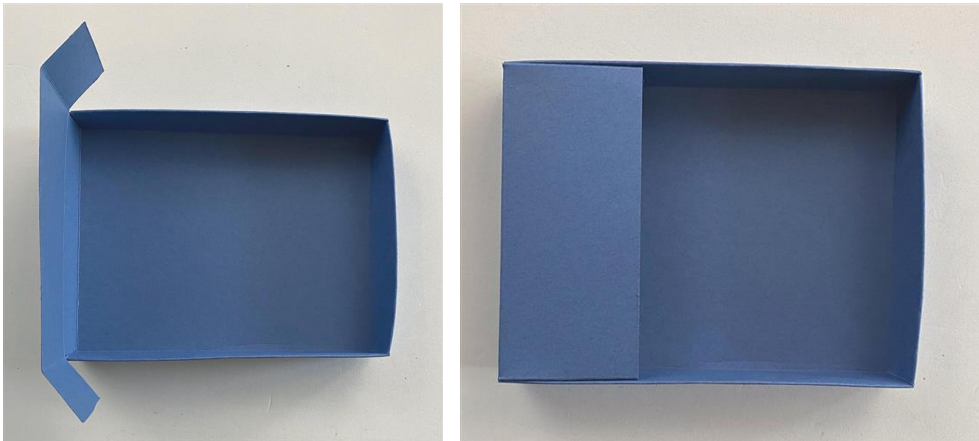
Fold up

Add the side and top pieces.



For the cards, cut 3" x 4" pieces of Designer Series Paper. Layer those on 3-1/4" x 4-1/4" pieces of cardstock.

Add a 3/4" x 4" strip of coordinating patterned paper. Add to card front.
