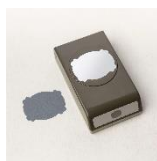

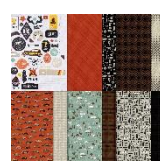

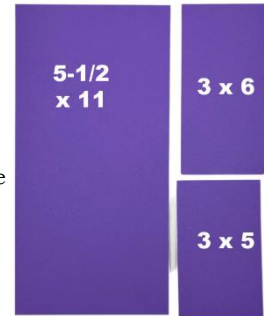

These are the pieces you will need:



1. Start with an 8-1/2" x 11" piece of card stock. Cut it at the 5-1/2" mark like the photo shows. >>

This will leave you with a 3" x 11" piece of card stock which you will cut at 6". Now you have the two pieces you need for this card and you can save the 3" x 5" piece for a future project.



2. Score the base card along the 11" edge at 1-3/4", 3-1/2", 5-1/4" and 7". Accordion fold.



3. Add the extra pieces. Put adhesive on the two outside edges of the 6" x 3" piece of card stock and attach it to the card base like this. >>

4. Add your sentiments and embellishments to the smaller piece and your card if finished!
