



Quick & Easy Slider Card Project Sheet

Island Indigo



Whisper White



Bohemian



3/4" Circle Punch

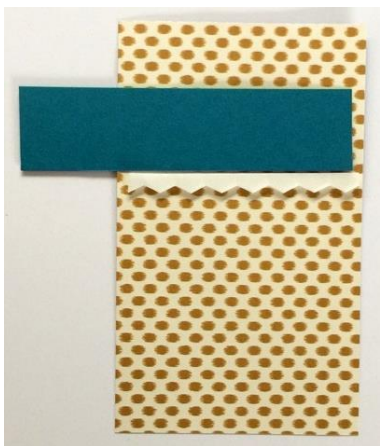

Start with a base card of Island Indigo 4" x 11", scored at 5 1/2" and folded. The reason for doing 4" wide instead of the usual 4 1/4" is to have room for the slider and the flower to extend over the card.

The Whisper White layer is 3 3/4" x 5 1/4" and the Bohemian DSP is 3 1/2" x 5".



To make the opening, I used the 3/4" Circle Punch. I punched each end of the opening, and then, moving very little each time, I kept punching until the two met. (You could use a paper cutter instead if you prefer.)



Since the opening is 3/4" wide, I cut a piece of card stock 1" wide for the slider. Laying that on the back side of the DSP, I added strips of dimensional above and below to create the sliding track.

Put the pieces together and you have a fun slider card!
