

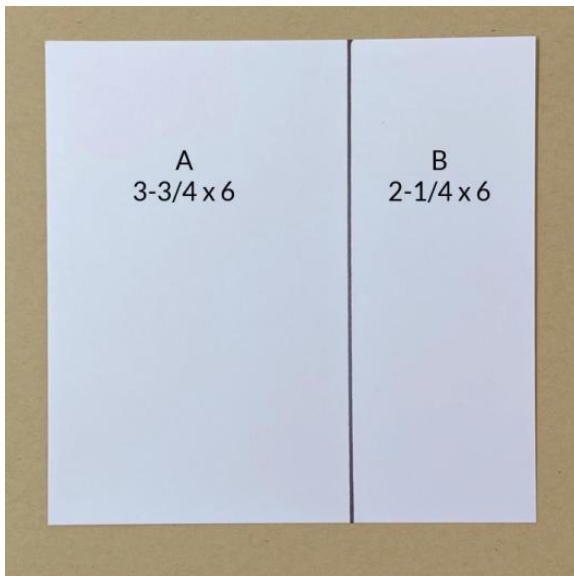
All Good Cards Club – January 2022

A Dozen Ways to Use 6x6 Paper Online Class One Sheet Cards and Envelopes – Session 1

Three designs that make a card and matching envelope out of one 6 x 6 paper.

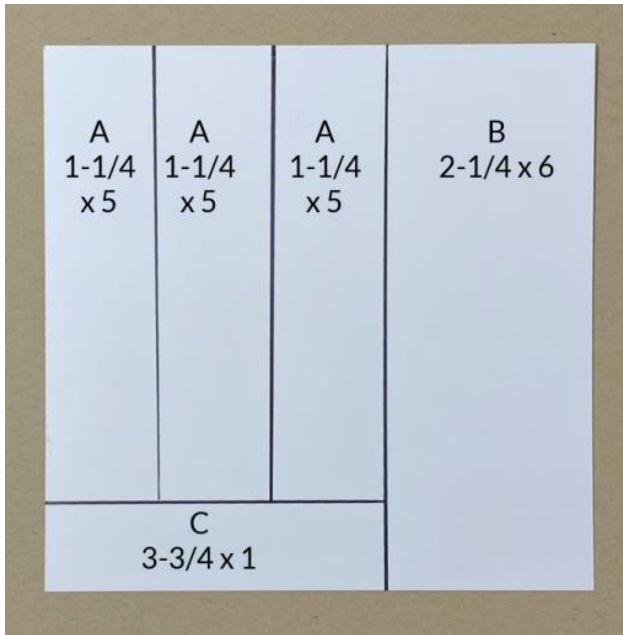
Design #1 – Rip and Flip Card

Rip piece A and flip one piece over before attaching to the 4 x 5-1/4 layer of cardstock. Layer this on a regular card base. (Tip: Cut several pieces of coordinating paper at the same time to create a set of cards like this. Feel free to mix and match the torn pieces to get a variety of looks.)



Design 2 - Three Panel Card

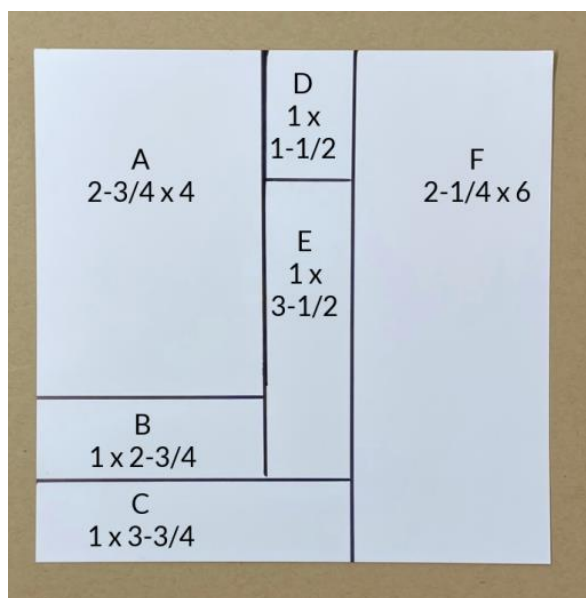
The three A pieces create one card with piece C for the card inside. Use the same side for all three panels or flip one over. (Cut multiples at one time and create lots of different looks mixing and matching your strips.)



Design #3 - Cut Aparts

A B D and E are layered on the front of the card. C is for the inside.

(Try cutting several coordinating papers at once and mixing up the designs)

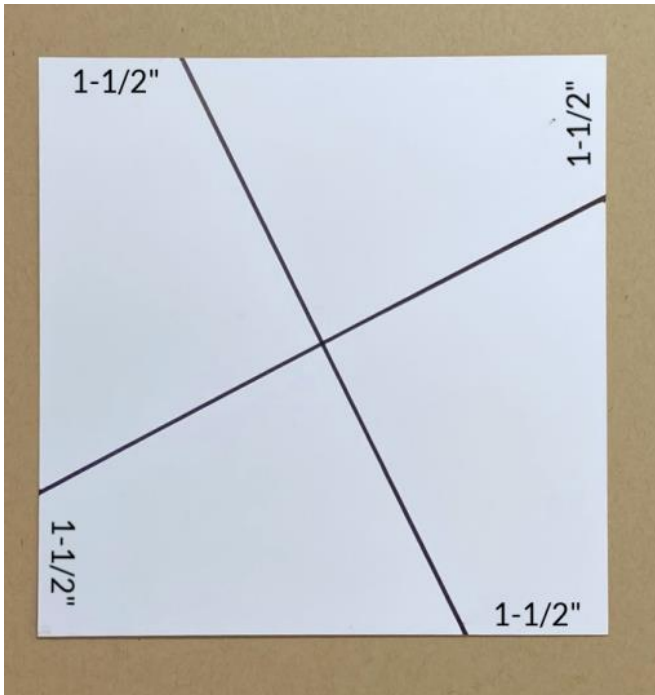


Two designs for quick cards with 6 x 6 papers

Design #4

Mark 1-1/2" from each corner and connect the lines like this. Each piece will make four cards. Add them directly to your card fronts or layer them on a 4" x 5-1/4" layer of cardstock first.

Try different measurements such as 1-1/4 to vary the design.

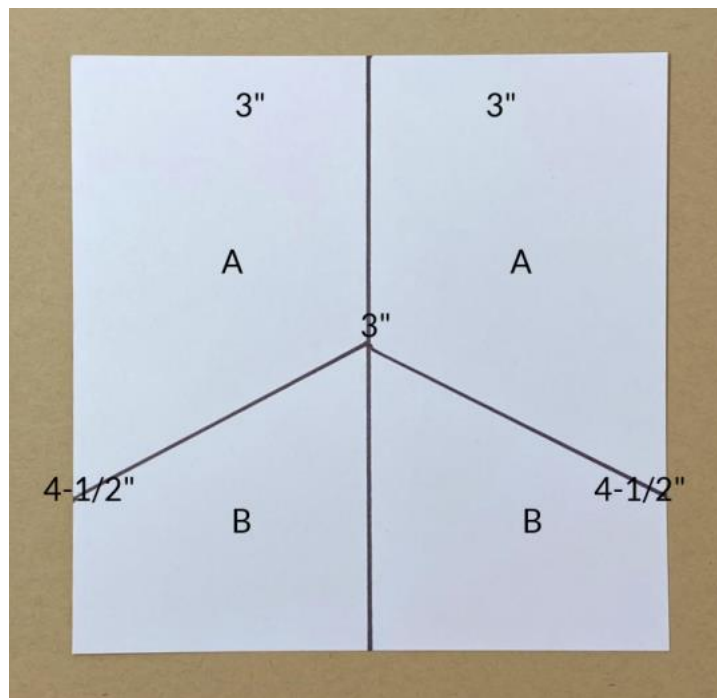


Cut several pieces of paper at the same time to create a variety of cards fast!
