## Gatefold Cards Vol 2 Online Class – Session 1


## **Double Crossover Gatefold Card #1**

The accent piece crosses over one direction and the sentiment strip does the opposite.

(This card uses the <u>Rain or Shine Designer Series Paper</u> along with <u>Balmy Blue</u> and <u>Mango Melody</u> cardstock.)







- 1. Score the base card 2-1/8" in from each side and fold to meet in the middle.
- 2. Add a strip of Designer Series Paper to each side of the card front.
- 3. For the accent piece, use any circles, squares or other die cuts. Decorate as desired.
- 4. Add adhesive just to the left side. Attach this to the left panel of the card front. (This card uses a 2-3/4" circle.)
- 5. Stamp the sentiment on a piece of paper and trim the paper to fit. This will be layered on another strip of cardstock and attached just to the right panel of the card front.

(This card has an extra 1" wide strip of Mango Melody under the sentiment strip.)

## **Double Crossover Gatefold Card #2**

This card has two equal panels crossing over the card front. In the next session, we will be adding to this theme!

(This card uses the <u>Happy Forest Friends Designer Series Paper</u> with <u>Calypso Coral</u> and <u>Blushing Bride cardstock.</u>)







- 1. Score the base card 2-1/8" from each side and fold to meet in the middle.
- 2. Add a 1-7/8" x 5-1/4" strip of Designer Series Paper to each side of the card front.
- 3. Layer the smaller pieces of Designer Series Paper on the 2-1/2" x 4" pieces of cardstock.
- 4. For the top piece, add adhesive to the left side of the back and attach it to the top of the card front, lining it up to the top and side edges of the Designer Series Paper.
- 5. Repeat with the bottom piece, but change the adhesive to the right side and attach this to the bottom of the card front. (There will be a little space between the two panels that shows off the coordinating Designer Series Paper.)
- 6. Add the largest piece of Designer Series Paper to the inside of the card and complete as desired.
