Gatefold Cards Vol 2 Online Class – Session 2

Triple Gatefold Panel Card

The circle piece overlaps the three panels just a bit and helps keep the card closed.

(This card uses the Butterfly Kisses Designer Series Paper and Fresh Freesia cardstock.)





Supplies:



Stamping on the Back Porch * Karen Titus karentitus.com * stampingonthebackporch@gmail.com

- 1. Score the 8-1/2" x 5-1/2" piece of cardstock @ 2-1/8" from each side.
- 2. Add the strips of Designer Series Paper to the strips of cardstock.



3. Add adhesive to half of the backs like this. >>



- 4. Attach two of the strips to the top and bottom of the left side of the card front first, leaving a 1/4" space around the edges.
- 5. Attach the middle one to the right side.
- 6. Add the circle to the center strip so that it overlaps just a bit on both the top and bottom strips.



Triple Gatefold Panel Card Version 2

This version creates a snug fit all on its own.


Note that we are using a 12" piece of cardstock for this card for easy measurements.






(This card uses the Rain or Shine Specialty Designer Series Paper with Balmy Blue and Mango Melody cardstock.)

Supplies:



Stamping on the Back Porch * Karen Titus karentitus.com * stampingonthebackporch@gmail.com

- 1. Score the card base @ 2", 4", 8" and 10" and fold.
- 2. Add the Designer Series Paper pieces.



- 3. For the card front, cut the 3-3/4" x 4-1/2" piece of Designer Series Paper into three 1-1/2" strips.
- 4. Attach these to the 4" x 5-1/2" piece of cardstock. Start with the top and bottom pieces first leaving a 1/4" space around the edges. Add the middle piece.



- 5. Cut the cardstock between the strips to make three panels for the card front.
- 6. Add adhesive on the back of each piece just as you did in the card above.
- 7. Attach the top panel to the left side of the card front, lining it up along the top and side edges.
- 8. Repeat with the bottom panel.

9. Add the middle panel just to the right side of the card front. This will make a snug fit. Decorate.
