



Fractured Card

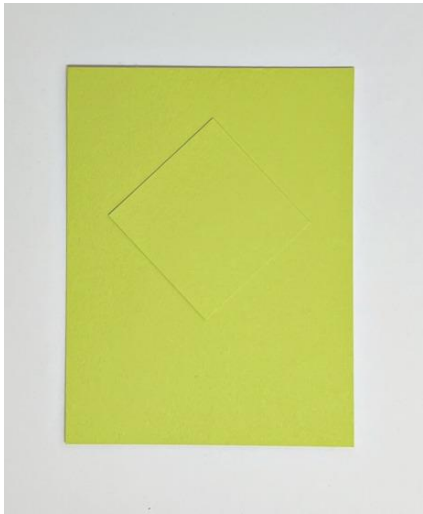

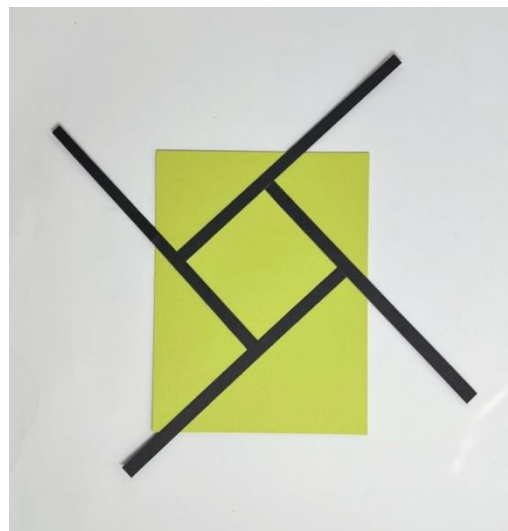
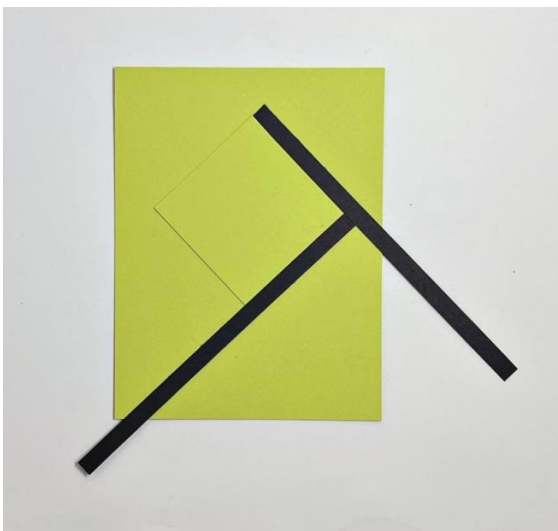


Attach a 2" square (die cut or regular cut) at an angle like this on a 4" x 5-1/4" inch piece of the same color cardstock.

Cut four 1/4" x 5" pieces of cardstock in a coordinating color. Add adhesive. (Using a silicone mat with the glue will keep your work area clean when using such narrow pieces.)



Add these layers around the small square like this. Trim the edges and attach to the base card. Add a 1-3/4" square of Basic White card stock to the center and decorate!





Make a stepped up card by changing from a square shape to another geometric shape. The process is the same as with the square except that you will need six strips and you cut one edge of each at an angle.

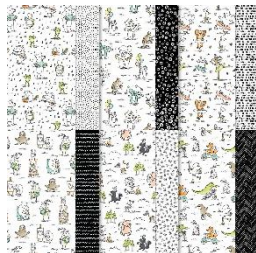

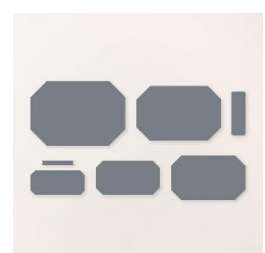
