

Project Sheet: Mini Cards on A Regular Card Base

These little cuties are perfect for any occasion, packing a punch of creativity with just a few folds. Whether you're using fun paper or your favorite stamps, this project offers endless possibilities.

Supplies:

[Poppy Parade](#) :: 4-1/4" x 5-1/2", 6" x 3"

[Basic White](#) :: 4" x 5-1/4", 2-3/4" x 2-3/4"

Snowy Scenes DSP :: 2-3/4" x 2-3/4"

Drusy Adhesive-backed embellishments

Instructions:

1. Layer the Basic White piece in the Poppy Parade card base.
2. Score the 6" x 3" piece of cardstock in half and fold to make the mini card. Adhere the 2-3/4" x 2-3/4" DSP square on the front of the mini card and the 2-3/4" x 2-3/4" Basic White square on the inside. Adhere this to the main card base.
3. Fussy cut the images from the Designer Series Paper and add to the card.
4. Finish off with embellishments.

Step it Up!

Add a 2" Basic White square layered on a 2-1/4" Poppy Parade square on the front of the mini card.
