

Project Sheet: Torn Edges Card

Torn edges can give your cards a lovely aged look or a rugged texture, depending on how you tear the paper. It's a super simple technique—just grab some patterned paper and let your creativity flow.

Experiment with different tearing styles and see how they can transform your designs.

Supplies:

[Wild Wheat](#) :: 5-1/2" x 8-1/2"

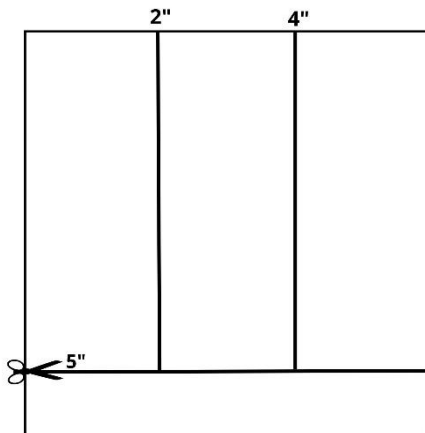
[Wild Wheat In Color DSP](#) :: 2" x 5" (X2)

[Basic White](#) :: 4" x 5-1/4" (X2)

Accent piece

Instructions:

1. Score an 8-1/2" x 5-1/2" card base in half and fold.
2. Prepare two 2" x 5" DSP pieces. If you are using 6x6 papers, cut off an inch then cut it into three 2" strips.



3. Adhere the two 2" x 5" DSP strips on a 4" x 5-1/4" piece of Basic White (torn edges facing towards the center). Then adhere this to the card front.
4. Add the remaining 2" x 5" DSP piece on the inside of the card.
5. Add your accent piece/sentiment.
