

## Project Sheet: Punched Cards

We all love a crafting shortcut, and this technique will show you how to punch your way to stunning cards effortlessly!

You can achieve stunning results with minimal supplies—just punches and stamps!

### Supplies:

[Otterly Adorable](#) :: 3-3/4" x 10"

[Lost Lagoon](#) :: 4-1/4" x 5-1/2"

[Pretty Peacock](#) :: 4" x 5-1/4"

[Basic White](#) :: 3-1/2" x 4-3/4"

[Modern Oval Punch](#)

[Drusy Embellishments](#)



### Instructions:

1. Fold a 3-3/4" x 10" DSP piece in half and punch out from the score line.
2. To make sure you get to stamp on the space perfectly, line up a 3-1/2" x 4-3/4" Basic White piece on the card inside first, then close the card before stamping on the punched-out part. Adhere the Basic White piece on the card inside.
3. Layer this first on a 4" x 5-1/4" piece of coordinating cardstock before adhering on a 4-1/4" x 5-1/2" card base.
4. Decorate and finish off with embellishments.
