

Project Sheet: Ink Blending Technique

Ink blending is a super fun and easy way to add a personal, creative touch to your projects, and the best part is—you can embrace the imperfections!

Supplies:

[Basic Gray](#) :: 11" x 4-1/4"

[Lost Lagoon](#) :: 5-1/4" x 4"

[Basic White](#) :: 3-3/4" x 5"

Stamp :: Friendly Seagulls

[Window Sheet](#)/Post it Note/Masking Tape

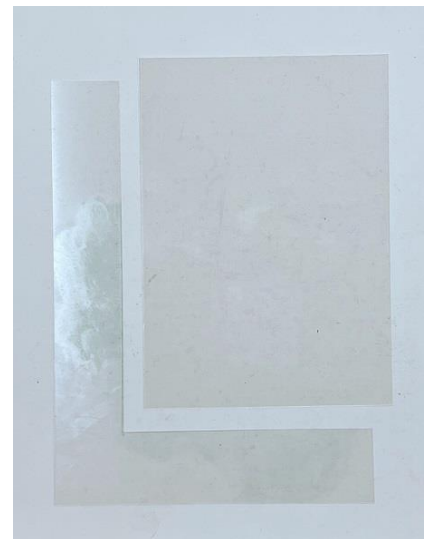
[Blending Brush](#)

Ink



Instructions:

1. Start by making some masks. I'm using a window sheet which I cut 1" wide on both the left and bottom part. The great thing about using a window sheet is that you can easily clean it and keep it for future use! *If you don't have window sheets, you can use post it notes or masking tape.*
2. Line up the window sheet mask on the Basic White and start inking with a Blending Brush.
3. Assemble your card.
