

Project Sheet: Easy Cards with 2" DSP Strips

When you're in a pinch and need to whip up some quick cards, 2" strip cards are my go-to solution! They're super simple and perfect for those moments when you're stuck or don't know where to begin.

Supplies:

Card Base :: 7-1/4" x 5-1/2"

Designer Series Paper :: 2" x 5-1/4" (X2)

Basic White :: 2-3/4" x 3-3/4"

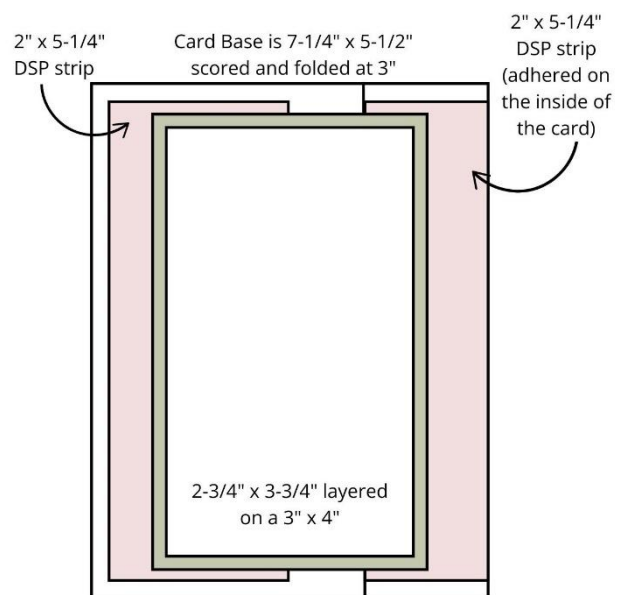
Coordinating Cardstock :: 3" x 4"



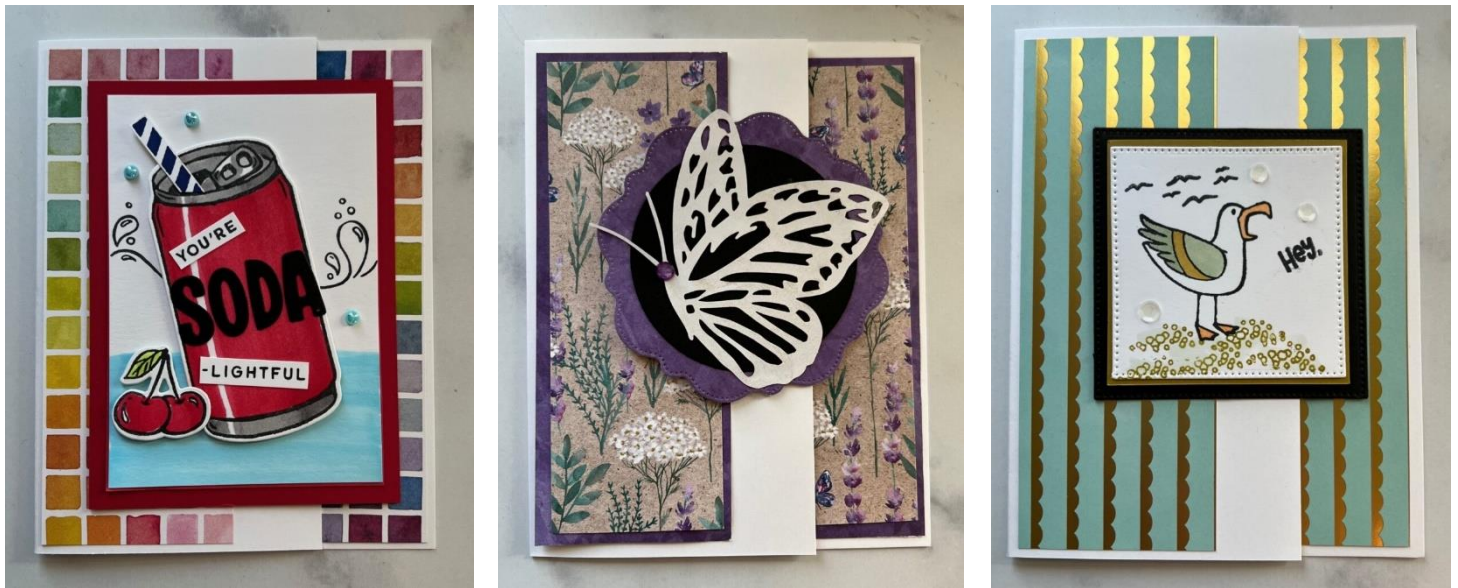
Instructions:

1. Score a 7-1/4" x 5-1/2" card base at 3" and fold.
2. Adhere one of the 2" DSP strips on the front flap towards the left side and adhere the other one on the inside of the card towards the right side so part of it will show on the card front.
3. Layer a 2-3/4" x 3-3/4" Basic White piece on a 3" x 4" piece of coordinating cardstock and adhere on the left front flap (make sure to only add adhesive on the left side).
4. Add an your accent and sentiment piece and embellish as desired.

***You can always change up the size of your sentiment piece.
