

Project Sheet: Double Z Accordion Card

Isn't it fun to give a fun fold card that looks tricky to make, but really isn't? Impress yourself as well as your friends with this Double Z Accordion Card.

Supplies:

Card Base :: 7-1/4" x 5-1/2"

Coordinating Cardstock :: 1-1/2" x 7-1/4" (X3)

DSP :: 1-1/4" x 4" (X3), 1-1/4" squares (X6)

Basic White :: 4" x 5-1/4"



Instructions:

1. Score the 7-1/4" x 5-1/2" card base at 1-1/2" x 3" and Z-fold.
2. Score the 1-1/2" x 7-1/4" strips at 1-1/2" x 3" and Z-fold.
3. Adhere the DSP strips and square pieces on the Z-fold strips.
4. Lay your card base flat with the Z-fold on the left side, turn over the strips so that the folded side are on the right. Put adhesive only on the left and right edges of the strips and adhere on the card base as shown.
5. Add your accent/sentiment pieces.
6. Adhere a 4" x 5-1/4" Basic White on the back for your message.
