

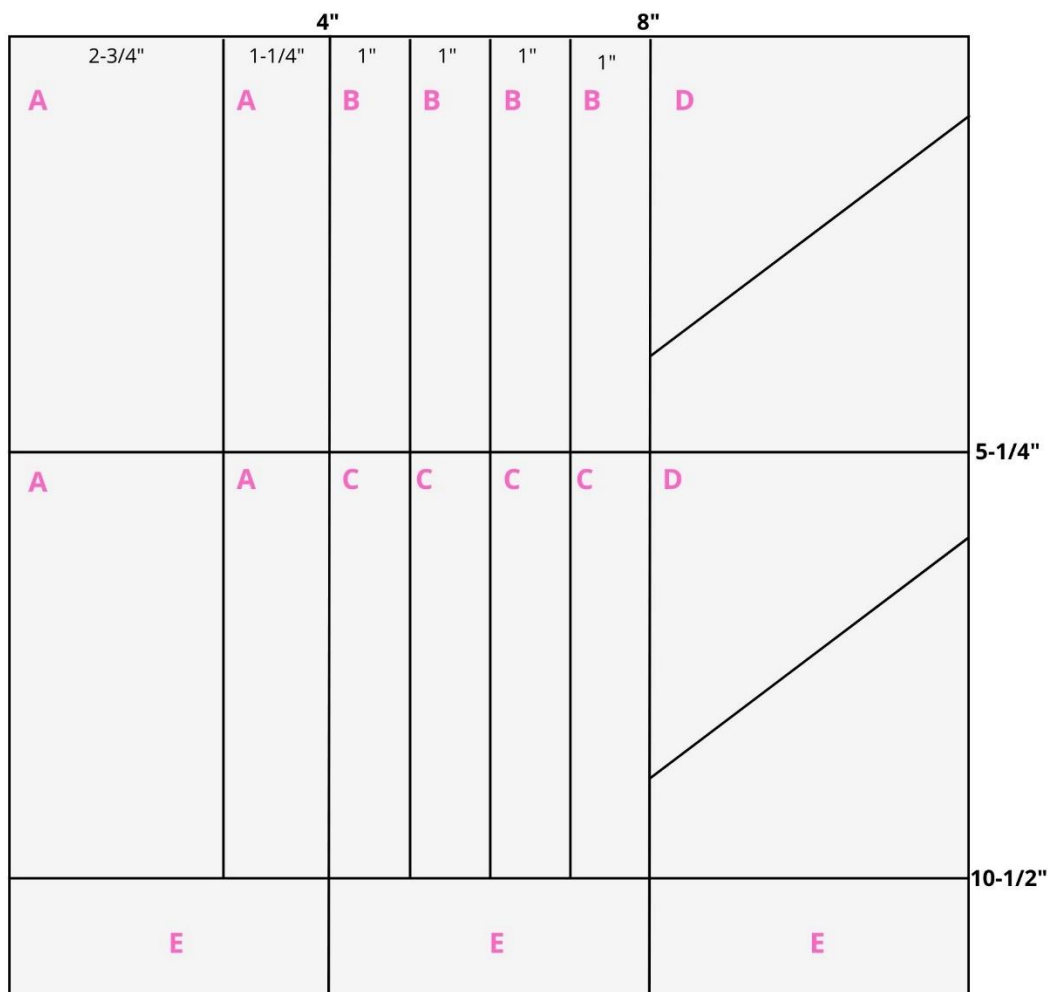


# Project Sheet: One Sheet Wonder Christmas Cards

Strips on Panel "A" will make two cards.

Cut 1-1/4" off from the card front of a regular base card. Adhere the 2-3/4" DSP strip on the front flap and the 1-1/4" DSP strip along the right side of the inside of the card.

The 1" strips will also make two cards.

Adhere three of the strips on the card front, and one strip on the inside of the card.

D

Cut the rectangle pieces on panel "D" diagonally. These pieces will also make two cards.

Adhere one of the pieces on the card front and the other on the inside of the card.
