

# Stamping on the Back Porch Project Sheet: One Simple Layout, 10 Unique Cards—Fast & Fun!

Isn't it fun to start with a simple card layout and then think of ways to make it your own?

The best part? This design works beautifully with different papers, colors, and sentiments, so no two cards ever have to look the same.

### Supplies:

Card Base :: 8-1/2" x 5-1/2"

Coordinating Cardstock :: 3-1/4 x 3-1/4"

DSP:: 3" x 3"

DSP:: 1-1/2" x 5-1/2"


Basic White insert :: 3-3/4" x 5"



#### Instructions:

- 1. Fold your card base in half and fold. Adhere a 3-3/4" x 5" Basic White on the inside of the card.
- 2. Adhere the 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" DSP strip across the card front.
- 3. Layer the 3" x 3" DSP square onto the 3-1/4" x 3-1/4" piece of coordinating cardstock. Adhere on the card front.
- 4. Add your accent and sentiment pieces.
