

Project Sheet: Pull-Out Gift Card Holder

This project combines simple folds with a clever design that's easy to recreate. You can use any Designer Series Paper or color combination to fit the occasion — from holidays and birthdays to thank-you gifts and celebrations. The best part is how the gift card slides out smoothly when the card is opened, giving your recipient a delightful surprise!

Supplies:

Card Base :: 8-1/2" x 5-1/2"


DSP :: 2-1/4" x 5-1/4" DSP :: 1-3/4" x 5-1/4"

Basic White :: 4-1/4" x 5-7/8"



Instructions:

- 1. Score the card base at 2" from one side and at 2-1/2" from the other side and fold both flaps inwards.
- 2. Adhere the 2-1/4" x 5-1/4" DSP piece on the 2-1/2" flap and the 1-3/4" x 5-1/4" DSP piece on the 2" flap.
- 3. For the insert, score the 4-1/4" x 5-7/8" Basic White piece at 2" from one side at 1/2" from the other side. Punch/cut half circle on the top edge of the bigger flap as shown.
- 4. Adhere the ½" flap of the insert along the score line of the card base as shown.
- 5. Put adhesive on both sides of the bottom flap to close up the pocket.
- 6. Add your accent/sentiment pieces.
