

## Project Sheet: Quick and Easy Gift Card Holder

These quick and easy gift card holders let you add that personal flair that says, “I was thinking of you.” You can match each one to your recipient’s interests—crafting, baking, reading, or anything else—and they come together in minutes! A little paper, a little creativity, and a whole lot of heart.

### Supplies:

Card Base :: 11" x 4-1/4"

DSP :: 2-1/4" x 5-1/4"

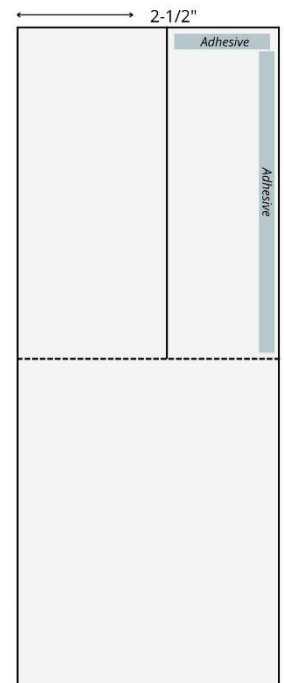
DSP :: 1-3/4" x 5-1/4"

Basic White :: 2-1/4" x 5-1/4"

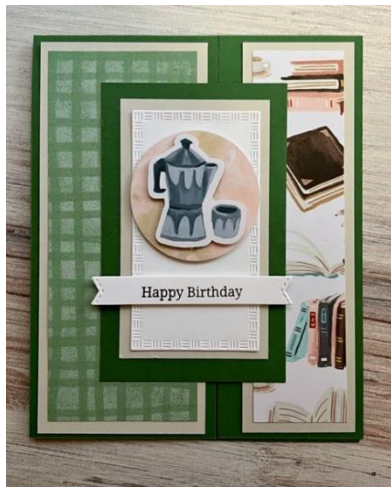


### Instructions:

1. Score the card base in half and fold. Cut the card front at 2-1/2" down to the center score line.
2. Add adhesive on the right and bottom edges of the right flap and adhere down to make the pocket.
3. Adhere the 2-1/4" x 5-1/4" Basic White piece on the left side of the inside of the card.
4. Adhere the 2-1/4" x 5-1/4" and 1-3/4" x 5-1/4" DSP pieces on the card front. *(If you want to add layers, just adjust the DSP measurements to 1/4 inch smaller.)*
5. Add your accent and sentiment pieces.
