

## Project Sheet: Split Front Panel Card

Ready for a fun fold that's almost *too* easy? Just one simple cut, a quick rearrange, and suddenly you have a card that looks completely different! It's such a playful way to change up your card fronts without any fuss. Add a few accents, pick your favorite Designer Series Paper, and you've got a card that's both quick and eye-catching.

## Supplies:

Card Base :: 4-1/4" x 11"

Basic White :: 4" x 5-1/4"

Cardstock :: 2-1/2" x 4-1/4"

DSP :: 2-1/4" x 4"


DSP :: 1-1/4" x 4" (X2)





## Instructions:

1. Score the card base at 5-1/2" and fold. Cut the card front at 1-1/2" and 3" from the score line.



- 2. Adhere the two 1-1/4" x 4" DSP strips (one on the top flap and the other one on the 1-1/2" x 4-1/4" piece that was cut from the card front.
- 3. Layer the 2-1/4" x 4" DSP piece on the 2-1/2" x 4-1/4" piece that was cut from the card front.
- 4. Assemble the card front pieces.
- 5. Adhere the 4" x 5-1/4" Basic White piece on the inside of the card.
- 6. Add your accent/sentiment piece.
