

## Project Sheet: One Designer Paper, Two Layouts!

Enjoy this fun way of making two different styles of cards from one piece of 12 x 12 Designer Series Paper. The Square Snippets Designer Series Paper is perfect for these cards because it has built in 3" squares, each different.

### Supplies:

Card Base :: 5-1/2" x 4-1/4"

Cardstock :: 4" x 5-1/4"

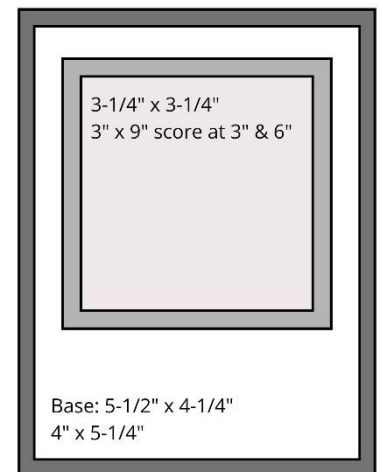
Cardstock :: 3-1/4" x 3-1/4"

DSP :: 3" x 9"

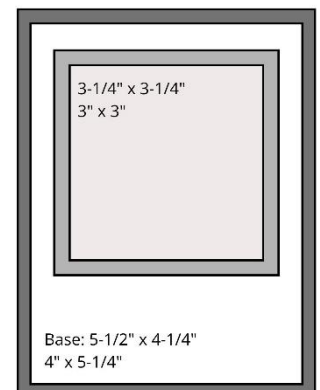


### Instructions:

1. Score the 3" x 9" DSP piece at 3" and 6" and accordion fold. Adhere the back of the last panel onto the 3-1/4" x 3-1/4" card stock piece.
2. Adhere on the 4" x 5-1/4" cardstock piece then onto the card base.
3. Decorate and embellish as desired.



When you cut your 12 x 12 paper into 3" x 9" to use for the first layout, you'll be left with 3" x 3" squares - and those are perfect for this second layout!



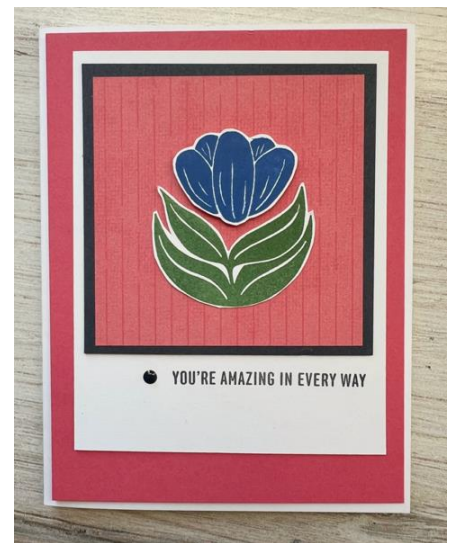
