

## Project Sheet: Just Cut it Diagonal

They're perfect for showing off your favorite Designer Series Papers. Add a soft focal point and a few coordinating accents, and you have a card that looks detailed without being fussy. This is the kind of layout you'll want to use again and again — just change the colors, sentiment, or paper patterns and you'll have a whole new look in minutes. Quick to assemble, lovely to give, and ideal for all kinds of occasions.

### Supplies:

Card Base :: 8-1/2" x 5-1/2"

DSP strips :: 4" x 5-1/4"

Accent/sentiment piece

### Instructions:

1. Score an 8-1/2" x 5-1/2" card base in half and fold.
2. Cut a 4" x 5-1/4" DSP piece diagonally in half.
3. Flip over one of the DSP pieces and adhere both on the card front.
4. Finish off by adding your accent/sentiment pieces.
