

Project Sheet: Fractured Cards

Fractured cards—sometimes also called faux shutter cards —are such a fun way to create something that looks intricate but is actually surprisingly simple to put together. I love how this technique breaks up your Designer Series Paper into sections, creating lots of visual interest while still keeping a clean, structured design.

Supplies:

Card Base :: 8-1/2" x 5-1/2"

DSP :: 4" x 5-1/4"

Cardstock strips :: 3/8" x 5-1/2" (X4)

Cardstock :: 2" square

Accent/sentiment piece



Instructions:

1. Adhere the 2" square (die cut or regular cut) diagonally on the center of the 4" x 5-1/4" DSP piece.
2. Put adhesive at the back of the 3/8" x 5-1/2" strips. Adhere around the edges of the 2" square piece as shown. Trim off the excess.
3. Adhere this on the card base.
4. Add your accent and sentiment pieces.
