

## Project Sheet: Easy Pocket Cards

There's something extra special about a card that holds a little surprise inside. You can tuck in a sweet note, a gift card, or even a little treat—such a thoughtful way to make your card feel more personal. And the best part? You can use whatever supplies you already have and let your paper do the work.

### Supplies:

Card Base :: 4-1/4" x 5-1/2"

Cardstock :: 4" x 10-1/4"

Basic White :: 3" x 5"

DSP :: 3-3/4" x 3-3/4"

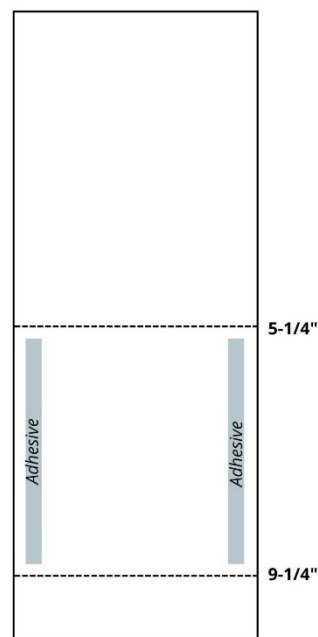
Cardstock :: 3/4" x 4"

Accent/sentiment piece



### Instructions:

1. Score the 4" x 10-1/4" cardstock at 5-1/4" and 9-1/4". Burnish the score lines.
2. Close the card (with the 5-1/4" score line at the bottom). Adhere the 3-3/4" x 3-3/4" DSP square on the front panel. Then add adhesive on the 1" top panel and adhere down.
3. Open the card and add adhesive on each side as shown >> then adhere down to make the "pocket".
4. Adhere this on the 4-1/4" x 5-1/2" card base.
5. For the insert, cut a 3" x 5" piece of Basic White and add an accent piece.
