



Project Sheet: Center Panel Z-Fold Card

This fold is also a great way to make your Designer Series Paper shine. A few coordinating patterns, a strong focal image, and simple layering come together quickly for a card that looks impressive without needing complicated measurements or techniques. Sometimes just changing the placement of one panel is enough to give a familiar fold a whole new look!

Supplies:

Card Base :: 8-1/4" x 5-1/2"

Basic White :: 3-1/4" x 4-1/4"

DSP :: 3" x 4"

DSP :: 1" x 5-1/4"

DSP :: 2-1/2" x 5-1/4", 1-1/2" x 5-1/4"

Basic White insert (optional) :: 2-1/4" x 5-1/4"



Instructions:

1. Score the 8-1/4" x 5-1/2" card base at 4-1/4" and 7" and Z-fold.
2. Adhere the 1" x 5-1/4" DSP strip on the center panel.
3. Adhere the 2-1/2" x 5-1/4" DSP piece on the left panel. And adhere the 1-1/2" x 5-1/4" DSP piece on the right side of the inside of the card.
4. Layer the 3" x 4" DSP piece onto the 3-1/4" x 4-1/4" coordinating cardstock. Adhere this on the center panel.
5. Stamp your sentiment and finish off with embellishments.
