

Project Sheet: Trifold Card

What I especially love about this card layout is how efficient it is for using up Designer Series Paper. This design uses a 12" x 3" strip of DSP, which means you can get 4 cards from one 12" x 12" sheet.

Supplies:

Card Base :: 4-1/4" x 5-1/2"

DSP :: 4" x 5-1/4"

DSP :: 12" x 3"

Basic White :: 2" x 4" (X2)

Accent/Sentiment piece



Instructions:

1. Adhere the 4" x 5-1/4" mat layer on the 4-1/4" x 5-1/2" card base.
2. Score the 12" x 3" DSP piece at 3-1/4", 8-1/2", and 11-1/4". Accordion fold. Adhere this on the card front.
3. Adhere one of the 2" x 4" Basic White pieces on the inside of the card.
4. Stamp your sentiment and adhere your accent pieces on the other 2" x 4" Basic White piece. Adhere this on the 3/4" panel front flap of the DSP.
