

Project Sheet: Woven Heart

This project combines simple paper weaving with cozy Scandinavian charm to create a card that feels unique, nostalgic, and beautiful. It's a fun way to play with paper strips and create something that looks intricate without being difficult.

Supplies:

Card Base :: 8-1/2" x 5-1/2"

DSP :: 2" x 5-1/4"

DSP :: 2" x 5-1/4"

DSP :: scrap for die cutting

Everyday Arches Dies



Instructions:

1. Score the card base in half and fold.
2. Adhere the two DSP strips on the card front.
3. Using Everyday Arches Dies, die cut two arches of the same size from scrap pieces of DSP. Adhere together diagonally to form the heart shape. Adhere on the card front using dimensionals.

To make the woven heart: (watch the video in the link below to see the technique)

Cut the bottom part of the die cuts into strips and weave.



The card on the left was cut into two strips while the card on the right was cut into four strips.
