



Pooh Party on the Back Porch

All of these cards features the Silly Old Bear Designer Series Paper. The great thing about these card layouts is that they are perfect for mass producing a bunch of cards in just minutes!

Supplies:

Card Base :: 8-1/2" x 5-1/2"

Silly Old Bear DSP :: 4" x 5-1/4"

Coordinating Cardstock :: 4" x 2-1/2"



Instructions:

1. Score the 8-1/2" x 5-1/2" card base in half and fold.
2. Adhere the 4" x 5-1/4" DSP piece on the card front.
3. Adhere the 4" x 2-1/2" piece of coordinating cardstock across the card front.
4. Cut an image scene from the DSP, layer this onto a piece of coordinating cardstock that is larger by 1/4" than the DSP cut out to make an even border. Adhere on the card front.

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Supplies:

Card Base :: 8-1/2" x 5-1/2"

Basic White :: 4" x 5-1/4"

Silly Old Bear DSP :: 3-3/4" x 3-1/4"

Coordinating Cardstock :: 1/2" x 3-3/4"

Sweet Words & Labels Dies



Instructions:

1. Score the 8-1/2" x 5-1/2" card base in half and fold.
2. Adhere the 4" x 5-1/4" Basic White piece on the card front.
3. Adhere the 3-3/4" x 3-1/4" DSP piece on the bottom part of the card front.
4. Adhere the 1/2" cardstock strip on the top edge of the DSP piece.
5. Die cut/fussy cut images from the DSP and adhere on the card front using dimensionals.

Supplies:

Card Base :: 8-1/2" x 5-1/2"

Basic White :: 3-1/4" x 4-1/4"

Silly Old Bear :: 2-3/4" x 4" (X2)

Circle Punch :: 1-3/4", 2", 2-1/4"

Triple Banner Punch



Instructions:

1. Score the 8-1/2" x 5-1/2" card base in half and fold.
2. Adhere the two 2-3/4" x 4" DSP pieces onto the 3-1/4" x 4-1/4" Basic White piece. Then adhere on the card front.
3. Punch a banner from a scrap piece of coordinating cardstock using the Triple Banner Punch. Adhere this on the card front – right on top where the edges of the two DSP pieces meet.
4. With the smallest circle punch. Punch out an image from the DSP piece, layer this onto a bigger circle then layer again onto a bigger circle piece. Adhere on the card front.

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Supplies:

Card Base :: 8-1/2" x 5-1/2"

Coordinating Cardstock :: 4" x 5-1/4"

Silly Old Bear DSP :: 3-3/4" x 5"

Baker's Twine

Sweet Words & Labels Dies



Instructions:

1. Score the 8-1/2" x 5-1/2" card base in half and fold.
2. Layer the 3-3/4" x 5" DSP piece onto the 4" x 5-1/4" piece of coordinating cardstock. Loop around Baker's Twine and adhere on the card front.
3. Using the frame die from Sweet Words & Labels, die cut a scene from the DSP. Adhere on the card front using dimensionals.
4. Stamp the sentiment on the smaller label die cut and adhere on the card front.

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Supplies:

Card Base :: 8-1/2" x 5-1/2"

Coordinating Cardstock :: 4" x 5-1/4"

Coordinating Cardstock :: 2-3/4" x 4-1/4"

Silly Old Bear DSP :: 2-1/2" x 4"

Hundred Acre Woods Embossing Folder



Instructions:

1. Score the 8-1/2" x 5-1/2" card base in half and fold.
2. Run the 4" x 5-1/4" piece of coordinating cardstock through the Hundred Acre Woods embossing folder. Then adhere on the card front.
3. Layer the 2-1/2" x 4" DSP piece onto the 2-3/4" x 4-1/4" piece of coordinating cardstock and adhere on the card front.

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Supplies:

Card Base :: 8-1/2" x 5-1/2"

Very Vanilla :: 4" x 5-1/4"

Silly Old Bear DSP :: 5" x 2-1/2"

Silly Old Bear DSP :: 5" x 1-1/2"

Sweet Words & Labels Dies

Ribbon



Instructions:

1. Score the 8-1/2" x 5-1/2" card base in half and fold.
2. Adhere the two DSP pieces onto the Very Vanilla piece. Loop ribbon around right where the edges of the two DSP pieces meet. Then adhere this on the card front.
3. Using the Sweet Words & Labels dies, die cut a scene from the DSP. Layer this onto a bigger die cut piece then adhere on the card front using dimensionals.
