

Project Sheet: Simple Card Layout that Makes Small Accents Shine

This simple design lets small accent pieces or a narrow accent strip take center stage, making it a perfect way to show off a favorite paper, color, or small detail. It's quick to make, easy to customize, and works for just about any occasion. Sometimes the simplest layouts are the ones we reach for again and again—and this just might become one of those for you.

Supplies:

Card Base :: 8-1/2" x 5-1/2"

Basic White :: 4" x 5-1/4"

DSP :: 3-3/4" x 3-3/4"

Accent/Sentiment piece



Instructions:

1. Score the card base in half and fold.
2. Adhere the 3-3/4" x 3-3/4" DSP piece on the bottom part of the 4" x 5-1/4" Basic White piece. Then adhere this on the card front.
3. Add your accent piece along the top edge of the DSP piece.
4. Add your sentiment piece.
