

## Project Sheet: Easel Pop-Up Card

Easel cards have always been one of my favorite fun folds because they look so impressive when they're standing up, but they're actually easier to make than you might think! I've shared quite a few easel card ideas over the years, and one of the things I love most about them is that there's always another variation to try.

### Supplies:

Card Base :: 8-1/4" x 5-1/2"

Cardstock :: 7" x 3-1/2"

DSP :: 4" x 5-1/4"

DSP :: 1-7/8" x 5-1/4" (X2)

DSP :: 3-1/4" x 3-1/4"

Basic White :: 3-1/4" x 3-1/4"

Cardstock :: 3/4" x 3"

Accent/Sentiment piece



### Instructions:

1. Score the 8-1/2" x 5-1/2" card base at 2-1/8" and 4-1/4" and Z-fold.
2. Turn your card base vertically with the two smaller panels at the bottom, adhere the two 1-7/8" x 5-1/4" DSP strips on the bottom two panels as shown. Then adhere the 4" x 5-1/4" DSP piece on the top panel.
3. To create the mini card, score the 7" x 3-1/2" in half and fold. Adhere the 3-1/4" x 3-1/4" DSP piece on the front and the 3-1/4" x 3-1/4" Basic White piece on the inside.
4. Adhere the mini card on the card base. Then adhere your accent pieces.
5. Put dimensionals on the bottom half of the 3/4" x 3" cardstock strip piece then adhere this on the bottom most panel (this will serve as the latch to prop up the mini card).
