

Project Sheet: Reverse Flip Card

What if you could take one of your favorite fun folds and give it a whole new personality with just one simple change? There are a handful of fun folds that never seem to go out of style, and the classic Z Fold is definitely one of them.

Supplies:

Card Base :: 8-1/2" x 5-1/2"

Coordinating Cardstock :: 4" x 5-1/4"

Basic White :: 3-3/4" x 5"

Coordinating Cardstock :: 1-7/8" x 5-1/4"

DSP :: 1-5/8" x 5"

Coordinating Cardstock :: 3" x 4-1/4"

Basic White :: 2-3/4" x 4" (X2)

Accent/Sentiment pieces

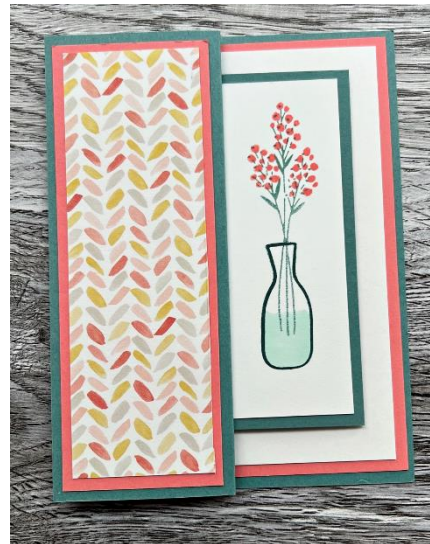


Instructions:

1. Score the card base at 2-1/8" and 4-1/4" and Z-fold.
2. Layer the 3-3/4" x 5" Basic White piece onto the 4" x 5-1/4" piece of coordinating cardstock. Then adhere this on the inside of the card.
3. Layer the 1-5/8" x 5" DSP strip onto the 1-7/8" x 5-1/4" strip of coordinating cardstock. Adhere this on the left front flap.
4. To make the center flap piece, adhere the two 2-3/4" x 4" Basic White pieces on the front and back of the 3" x 4-1/4" piece of coordinating cardstock. Put adhesive only on the left half of this piece. Then with the card base open, align this piece on the middle of the inside of the card and close the left front flap to adhere down.
5. Add your accent/sentiment pieces.
