

Project Sheet: Shaped Cards using Large Dies

One way to get even more from your crafting supplies is by turning large dies into shaped cards! Instead of the regular A2, a shaped card instantly adds a fun surprise while still being just as easy to make. If you have oversized dies tucked away in your collection, this is a great reminder to pull them out and let them become the star of your project.

Supplies:

Card Base :: 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" or 4-1/4" x 11"

Large Dies

Accent/Sentiment piece



How to Make a Shaped Card Base:

Creating the shaped card base is surprisingly simple. Fold your regular 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" or 4-1/4" x 11" card base in half, then place the large die so that the top edge of the die extends just beyond the folded edge of the cardstock. Run it through your die-cutting machine, leaving that small section uncut. This keeps the two layers attached, giving you a folded shaped card base that's ready to decorate however you'd like!
